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### Basic MLA for citing our textbooks

#### Works Cited

**Comment [K1]:** If I want to cite from anything written by the editors of the book, like the forward or the biographies of authors at the beginning of each selection, this is how I would do it.

**Comment [K2]:** Note that I give the complete page range for this selection, not just the page that I may be quoting or summarizing from.

Troyka, Lynn Quitman, and Douglas Hesse. *QA Compact*. 2<sup>nd</sup> ed. Upper Saddle River: Pearson, 2009. Print.

Paranthenetical notation (with sample page #): (Cox xiii), (Douglass 81), and (Troyka and Hesse 123)

**Comment [K3]:** Note that I use the last name of the author of the work FROM the anthology that I am quoting/summarizing from. I do NOT use the names of the editors if I am referring to Douglass's work.

**Comment [K4]:** If I am using more than 1 work from the same anthology, I can create an individual WC entry for the anthology itself, listed by editor, and then list each selection from that book that I'm using by author name, title of the piece, the editor's name, and page range. This takes up less space.
